You are a Goenkan - reach out for the Sky!





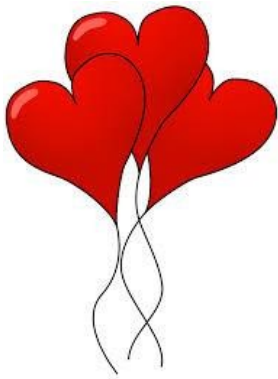
Colourful Capers!

Paste some GREEN things.

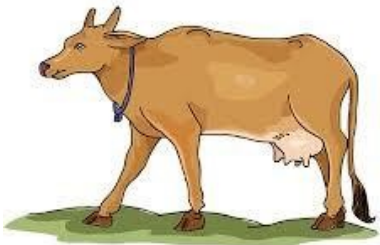


Orange is an orange,
